The Sanctum .

A space that evokes the silence of ruins, the permanence of stone, and the glow of relics. Here, architecture is stripped to its essence, arches, columns, niches, forms that have defined sacred places for millennia.

In the sanctum, contrast becomes experience:

Dark ribs against pale plaster, rough textures against glowing metal, permanence against impermanence. The atmosphere is one of reverence, not for religion, but for design, for the power of form and material to transport, to root us in history, and to hold space for stillness.



THE ALIGNMENT

ALIGNMENT TRANSFORMS PLAY INTO GEOMETRY. MARBLE DISCS SLIDE INTO POLISHED BRASS CHANNELS, TRACING LIGHT AND SHADOW INTO SHIFTING VERTICAL GRIDS. IT FEELS LESS LIKE A PASTIME, MORE LIKE ARRANGING FRAGMENTS OF A RUIN INTO SUDDEN, FLEETING ORDER.
