THE OCULUS GLOW RADIATES WITH A COPPER PATINA, AS THOUGH LIT BY THE SINGLE SHAFT OF LIGHT PIERCING A DOME. ITS SOFTENED OVAL FORM AND LUMINOUS FINISH HOLD THE QUIET INTIMACY OF A SANCTUARY, A TABLE THAT GLOWS AS MUCH IN SHADOW AS IN SUN.
