LIKE CLOTH TURNED TO STONE, THE VEIL TABLES CAPTURE THE FALL OF DRAPERY IN CAST METAL. THEIR SURFACES RIPPLE WITH FROZEN MOTION, AS IF FABRIC ONCE CAUGHT IN A MEDITERRANEAN BREEZE HAS BEEN SOLIDIFIED BY TIME. IN ANTIQUE BRASS, THEY GLOW WITH THE WARMTH OF RELICS UNEARTHED FROM A SUNKEN ATRIUM.
